



Preparing Your Items For Sale

Make the most of your consigning experience.

- Create your tags from our website, www.threebagsfull.info. Log into your account, click on "Work with Consigned Inventory" and get started. You'll enter info about your items and then print your tags. Six tags print per page.
- **Use ONLY white cardstock paper to print tags & use lightest (draft, etc) print mode.**
- Cut tags correctly! One tag per item only.
- DO NOT use colored paper and DO NOT use high-quality ink to print.
- Affix tags to clothing with a safety pin or a tagging gun. **(No straight pins, staples, etc)**
 - Put tag in a seam or in the manufacturer tag in the back neck. Do NOT place tag thru center of garment where a hole may be made.
- If the tag cannot be pinned, use CLEAR PACKING TAPE.
 - Do not use scotch tape, masking tape, and painter's tape as the tags WILL fall off.
 - Use one piece of packing tape across the center of the tag.
 - Test the tag... if your child could remove it, then so will others.
- **The description field is for your benefit. If the tag becomes misplaced, we keep it and attempt to find the item. The description allows us to do so.**
- Use Clorox wipes, etc to clean your toys, hi-chairs, etc. Febreze gets out musty smells and cigarette odors. Use a lint roller to remove all animal hair.
- There is a \$2.00 minimum price. Group books, shirts, one-sies, etc together to make a \$2 value. No miscellaneous "grab bag" of toys.
- Price your items to SELL. Consignors with a 90% or higher sell-thru rate will earn a "Skip Inspections" pass and have their Registration Fee refunded at the next season's event. Ask yourself "What would I pay for this item?" NOT "What can I get out of this item."
- It is YOUR responsibility to check for recalls on toys, baby equipment, etc. We highly recommend www.wemakeitsafer.com If your baby equipment is NOT recalled, place a "checkmark" on the back of the barcoded tag. If your item is inadvertently accepted at drop off and is later found to be recalled, a \$10 fee per item will be deducted from your earnings and the item will be removed from the sales floor.
- It is YOUR responsibility to correctly complete the "Claim Tickets" we provide for large items.
- Refer to the "*Items Accepted*" for each individual location for a complete list of items you can tag to sell. Please follow the "Items Accepted" carefully and do not deviate. If you're not sure, please email DeAnn for clarification. It is hard to list everything so asking is great!
- **Books & DVD's:** You may place several similar items in a Ziploc bag and place the tag on the outside of the front of the bag. You may also tie / rubber band several together. (DVD's will be checked at drop off, so do not tape them closed until after they have been inspected at drop off.)

- Video Games, Cartridges, etc: Tape the cartridge to a piece of cardboard, etc and place inside a gallon size Ziploc bag (taped closed). Tape the tag to the outside of the bag. (This helps to keep your coveted item safe and secure) ☺
- Shoes: use a rubber band, zip tie, etc to keep the shoes together. If necessary, place in a Ziploc bag and tape the tag to the outside of the bag.
- Designer Purses/wallets & Designer Diaper Bags: zip-tie to a hanger!!!! Additional Drop Off procedures are required for these items valued at \$25 or higher. **Notify a sale assistant at drop off if you are bringing a Designer Purse/wallet or Designer Diaper Bag.**
- Toys with pieces: place the pieces/parts in a Ziploc bag (taped closed) and then SECURELY tape the entire bag to the main part of the toy. If your child can get it apart, so can others.
- Boxed Toys & Games: be sure there are NO MISSING PIECES. These will be taped closed **after they have been inspected at drop-off.**
- Electronic Items: must be able to turn on!
- Clothing:
 - All clothing must be hung. Clothing in Ziploc bags will not be accepted. The hook of the hanger should face “left” so it looks like a question mark when looking at the front of the garment. **Refer to our videos for more info.** Socks, bibs, and accessories can be pinned to an outfit. Blankets, etc should be pinned to a hanger.
 - When hanging pants, lay pant on the back of the hanger and safety pin through the garment picking up the shoulder of the hanger. **WATCH OUR VIDEO!**
 - Outfits sell well, especially when everything matches.
 - If possible, use wire hangers to hang outfits (but any hanger is okay)
 - Put shirt on hanger. Flip it over. Pin pants to the shoulder area of the hanger, catching the shirt in the process. **WATCH OUR VIDEO!**
 - Put hair bows, socks, etc in a bag and pin to the shoulder of the hanger.
 - Sell tops/bottoms together when possible. Outfits sell quicker than pieces. Do not mix sizes unless the “fit” is appropriate to do so. Note that on the tag.
 - Carefully inspect your clothing for stains in a well lit room. Just because you think it is stain free doesn’t mean it is. No stains, excessive wear, pilling, tears, etc.
 - **Refer to the “Items Accepted” for appropriate brands, sizes and quantities prior to taking the time to tag your items.**

Best Sellers! Tag these items first!

1. Large, outside play structures: Play houses, climbing gyms, sand tables, wagons, picnic tables, etc.
2. Large, inside play structures: Kitchens, doll houses, work benches, etc.
3. Toys: All ages, types, etc including electronic.
4. Baby equipment: Strollers, pack-n-play’s, hi-chairs, etc.
5. Better Brand Clothing: any size, priced right, of course!
6. Shoe: high quality, no scuffs, excellent condition
7. Boys clothing, especially size 3T-16.
8. Sporting Goods Equipment
9. Authentic (with receipt attached) designer purses & diaper bags
10. American Girl Dolls & accessories for girls and Lego’s for boys!
