Sell...Shop...Serve!

*Be a Three Bags Full
Volunteer!*

Why?

**Volunteers save money on their Consignor Fee, shop earlier than non-volunteering consignors, can earn a higher percentage & have fun!*

**Without volunteers, your stuff won't sell! (And that's the goal, right?!)*

Who?

**YOU!! Dads also make GREAT volunteers! (Especially set-up, tear-down, pre-sale, security and parking lot safety)*

**Grandma's can volunteer too! (Or babysit while you volunteer!)*

**Mature 12 yr. olds & older can come with you. A great mom/daughter day!*

What?

**Help organize the sales floor*

**Help consignors dropping off their items*

**Help check out customers*

**Help set-up and tear-down all the racks (Lifting required. Wear gloves!)*

**Help shoppers find what they need & answer questions*

**Help with parking lot safety & building security*

How?

**Log into your Consignor Account and click on the Volunteer Links*

**Sign up for 1 shift to save money on your Consignor Fee & to shop earlier*

**Sign up for 2-6 shifts* to earn more and shop even earlier! (number of shifts available varies at each location. Refer to the bottom of the Consignor Agreement for details.)*

Basic Volunteer Information:

- Sign up for volunteer shifts via the online system. All shifts are 3 hours. Register early for best selection. Returning consignors register before new consignors. Always check the online Volunteer Schedule frequently, especially in the days right before the sale. Shifts often open up at the last minute!
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to your shift beginning so you can learn your station.
- **Sign in when you arrive. Sign out when you leave or your shift may not be counted!**
- Wear comfortable shoes. Bring snacks & drink with you. There is no food available to purchase.
- Dress appropriately for the outside weather temperature, but it is often cold in the fairgrounds buildings.
- **If volunteering for Drop-Off you must schedule a separate time to have your own items checked in.** (“Common sense” rule applies: bring your items and if there is time we’ll get it put out. However don’t “plan” on this in case there isn’t time!)
- **If you are volunteering for Pick-up bring someone with you to collect your items.**
- Please schedule appropriate childcare. Nursing? Contact DeAnn@threebagsfull.info.
- We do have “sit down” jobs available during the Public Shopping Times only. If you need to request one please email DeAnn@threebagsfull.info AFTER you scheduled your shift. These are not guaranteed. Public Shop days ONLY
- Husbands can volunteer too! Especially during set-up, tear-down, pre-sale, security & parking lot security! Want to volunteer together for the same shift? Contact DeAnn@threebagsfull.info to assign shifts. (This must be approved ahead of time or only one shift will count. Max of two volunteers per shift for the same consignor number. Team Leads Only at the Croton Location.)
- A \$25 per shift cancellation fee will apply for cancellations after the Volunteer Registration Deadline (per Consignor Agreement) or no-shows. You may also forfeit future volunteering privileges. We are counting on you!
- A maximum of \$200 can be earned volunteering. (The difference between 65% and your volunteer percentage.)
- Please be respectful of other families wanting to volunteer. Don’t “overbook” yourself and then cancel shifts at the last minute!

- **When you register for a shift, you are stating that you agree to this Volunteer Information as also stated in the Consignor Agreement.**

The Fine Print:

- View the exact volunteer schedule online using the “Consignor Login” link at www.threebagsfull.info. All shifts are scheduled online and may not be cancelled after the Volunteer Deadline for each respective sale. There are occasionally “at-home” jobs; these are “first come, first serve” be sure we have your email address on file!
- The Consignor Fee is based upon hours worked AND total Active Inventory item count in active inventory when the system closes. Refer to the Consignor Agreement for complete details.
- If we do not have enough volunteers to adequately staff the sale, all consignors NOT volunteering will be charged an additional \$20 “non-volunteer” fee. (Fortunately we have not needed to charge this at past sales. Notification prior to fee would be made.)
- In an effort to ensure the quality of the sale by retaining a sufficient number of volunteers, Three Bags Full requires that volunteers fulfill their pledged obligation to work their assigned 3-hour shifts. In the event a volunteer does not fulfill their obligation or find a suitable replacement on their behalf, Three Bags Full deducts a \$25 fee per shift not worked, based upon the online Volunteer Scheduling Report. The volunteer will forfeit future volunteer privileges. Some extenuating circumstances will be considered (such as a death in the family). In such situations the volunteer will be allowed to volunteer again, but the deduction from the consignor check may still be made at the discretion of Three Bags Full. Please understand that these guidelines have been created in an effort to maintain a high quality sale that benefits everyone.
